READING: We will be reading the story "Stan's Stunt" in our third reading. In this story we will: blends; story elements; possessives; and verbs. Spelling tests will be on every Friday afternoon during our reading time. Take time to practice the words each day. Please check the homework assignments as two of them will be on our spellings/sight words. Our reading book has plenty of opportunity to practice our reading skills. I will be sending home a short reader (8 pages) on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday evenings in addition to the book they pick from our classroom library. Please have your child read the story to you that evening and return it to school the following day so that they can get another book. These books will go home every week in a large plastic bag, included will be a blue slip so they can get credit on their reading chart.

PHONETICS: We will review our ending sounds.

SPELLING WORDS: SPPELLING WORDS: bump, went, spill, jump, tent, spell

SIGHT WORDS: try, fall, their, would

(Homework and the spelling test will be on both sets of words)

HANDWRITING: We will quickly review letters Xx, Yy and Zz, plus some of our numbers.

MATH: We finish chapter 3 this week with a test on Thurs. 11112. We will start chapter 4...data and graphing on Friday 11113.

SCIENCE: We begin module A in our science curriculum: Plants.

BIBLE TIME: We will read and discuss: Gideon.
